

Rainwater People: An Archeological View

Hindus (DNA F) are Asian Homo Sapiens; they have nothing to do with the African or European Homo Sapiens. They were rainwater people. They lived only along the lowlands of perennial rainwater rivers along the mountain ridges that were perpendicular to the monsoon winds. They avoided flatlands that were flood basins. They lived only above the waterline (500') and below the treeline (1,000'). They originated in Somalia 200,000 years ago, in the lowlands of the east coast of Africa. They followed the monsoon winds that blew from the Arabian Sea to the Bay of Bengal.

The following digitally generated elevation map traces the migration path of Hindus along the rainwater resources. They lived only in the circled areas at the stated time. They moved to a circle with a higher number when the monsoon winds reversed direction every 20,000 years.
