

Elevation Map: An Archeological View

Hindus (DNA F) are Asian Homo Sapiens. They had nothing to do with the African or European Homo Sapiens. They voluntarily left Ethiopia (Africa) 100,000 years ago and followed the monsoon winds from the Arabian Sea to the Bay of Bengal. They lived in the currently submerged Persian Gulf from 80,000 BCE to 10,000 BCE. The glaciers started to melt around 20,000 BCE, and the Gulf was totally submerged.

Not all of Asia was suitable for human habitation. The land above the treeline (1,000') was not arable. The following map is a digital reconstruction of the landscape to depict the habitable areas at the time Hindus voluntarily left Africa. In the map only the areas with the colors light blue, green, yellow, and orange were suitable for habitation. Hindus were highly advanced logic-based cultures. They sent out scouts far and wide in search of habitable lands. They avoided the Indus River of snowmelt water that was flood-prone and unstable. They lived only in the lowlands of rainwater rivers along the monsoon path.
