

The Hindu people, an Archeological View

Genetically, Hindu the native Indians, are the DNA F. They lived in the peninsular India, to the south of the Yamuna river, for over sixty thousand years. 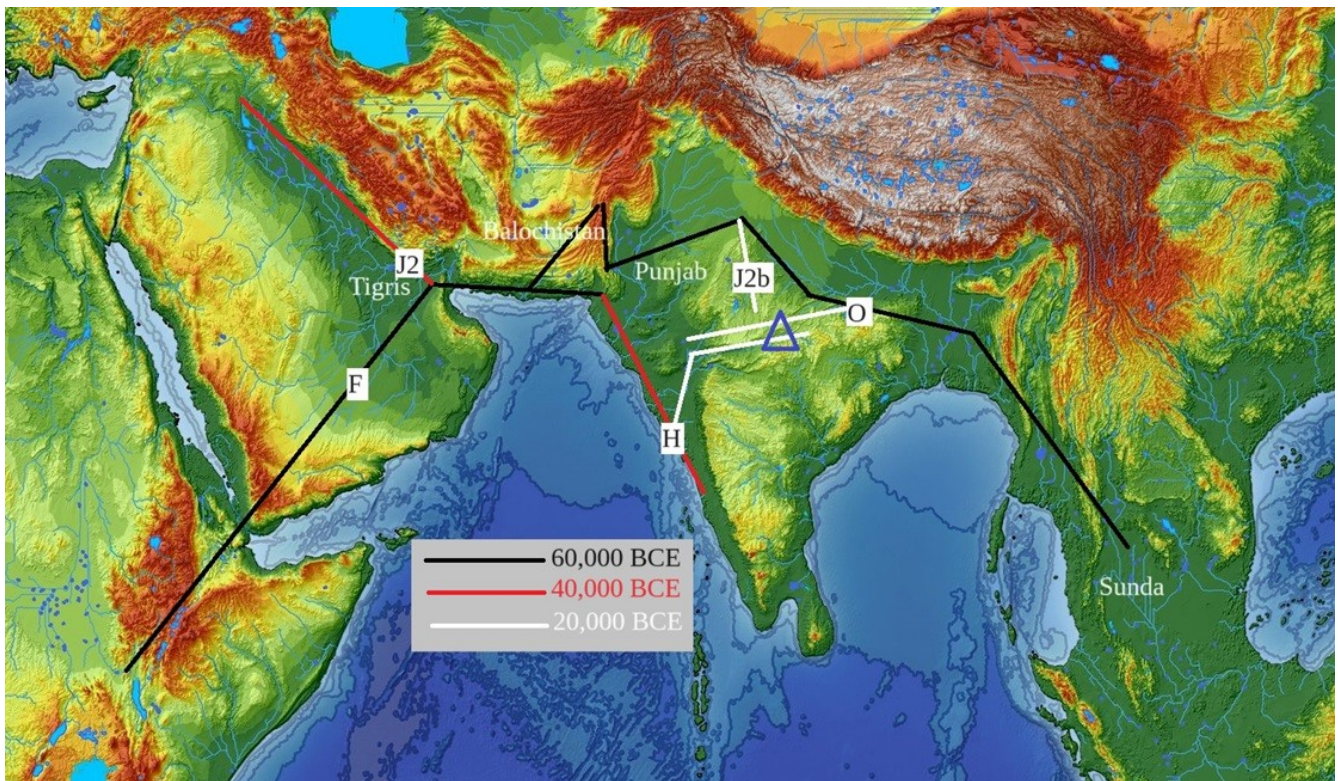

Every twenty thousand years, monsoon winds change direction based on the earth's rotation called Precession. Sixty thousand years ago, the current Thar desert was a fertile valley called Punjab. The F discovered a mountain pass in Balochistan and moved over to Punjab. From Punjab, they followed the Yamuna river to the Bay of Bengal (Sunda). They left their signature on the walls of the caves.

Sixty thousand years ago, the F lived only along the black line.

Forty thousand years ago, the monsoon winds changed direction and Punjab became the Thar desert. The F were forced to move south along the West Coast of India to the Narmada river delta. The Narmada is a rainwater river. They did not follow the Indus river because it was not a rainwater river.

Forty thousand years ago, the people in Sunda were the O subgroup of the F, the people in the Narmada delta were the H subgroup of the F, and the people in the Tigris were the J2 subgroup of the F. Punjab and Yamuna was vacated.

Twenty thousand years ago, the monsoon winds changed direction and the Thar desert became a fertile valley again. A subgroup of the J2 in the Tigris, called J2b, followed the old migration path to reach Punjab.

Twenty thousand years ago, the glaciers started to melt and the rising sea levels swallowed much of the land. The Narmada delta and Sunda were submerged under 500 feet of water. The H and O were forced to move to the mainland. They followed the white lines.

Five thousand years ago, Punjab started to become a desert again. The J2b in Punjab were forced to vacate. They moved along the Yamuna to the Mt. Trikuta of the Vindhya.

The three rivers Narmada, Sone, and Ken originated at the foot of the Trikuta and dispersed in different directions. There was a giant rainwater reservoir surrounding the Trikuta with inexhaustible supply of rainwater.

The three subgroups of the F (H, O, J2b) reached the Trikuta. They were the native Indians, Hindu. They were the only people on the entire subcontinent until the Europeans (R1) moved in four thousand years ago, from Bactria, and lived along the Himalayan ridge and Indus.
