

The Hindu University at Patna: An Archeological View

Twenty thousand years ago the Kui, Mundari, and Agni people moved to the foot of Mt. Trikuta of the Vindhya in search of dependable perennial rainwater. Their original homelands were submerged by the rising seawater levels caused by the glacial melt.

Agni (DNA J2b) lived along the Ken River and spoke the Grandhika dialects. Kui (DNA H) lived along the Hiran tributary of the Narmada River and spoke the Teli dialects. Mundari (DNA O) lived along the Sone River and spoke the Mundari dialects. The three rivers originated at the Trikuta reservoirs and flowed in different directions.

Around 2,200 BCE, there was a global drought that lasted for almost 200 years. The Trikuta reservoirs dried out, and all the people were forced to move east to the Mahanadi River. Over time, they spread out.

The Agni (Grandhika) established a university at Patna City (Bihar) to teach logic. The university had no central campus. The faculty were located all over the place. Students moved from one professor to the next. The original Rig Veda and Bhagavad Gita were books on Hindu logic composed in the Grandhika. Professors Vasudeva Krishna, Siddhartha, Ajatashatru, and Mahavira lived around Patna. They invented the Hindu Scientific Method, now known as the Logic of Hypothesis Testing.

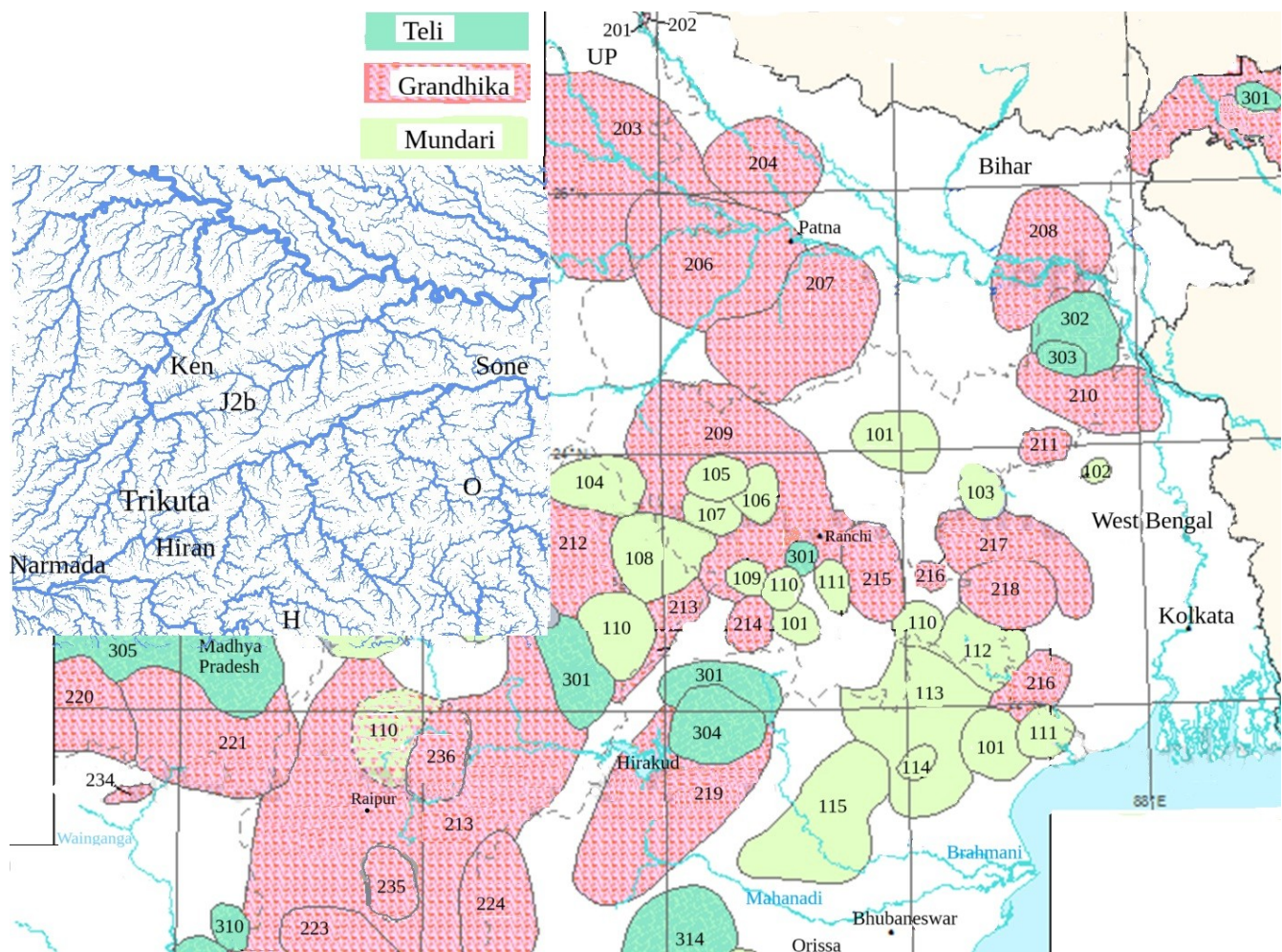
The Hindu University, logic, and cultures were deliberately destroyed by the Greek colonialists who moved to Patna after the collapse of the Gupta empire. Hindu logic was the exact opposite of Aristotle's logic. It was incomprehensible to the Greeks. The Greeks had to destroy it.

The South Bactria, called Avesta, were Central Europeans, the DNA R1a1. They were two rival gangs called Asura and Deva that hated each other. Asuras offered prayers to nature, called Yasna, to express their gratitude. They had no gods in human form. Devas were con artists. They invented fictional gods in human form, Shiva, Vishnu, and Indra, as miracle makers. They claimed to have acquired supernatural powers through meditation (tapas) to command the gods to perform miracles on demand. They invented fictional rituals called Yajna to command gods. A compilation of Yajna was the Vedas. They sold gods as snake oil to rob Avestans. Asura expelled Deva for their unethical and immoral social behavior of robbing people with Yajna. The untouchable Avestan Deva refugees in Kashmir were called Brahmin.

The Greeks (R1b) in India employed the unethical and immoral Avestan Brahmin to vandalize logic books at Patna University to worship manuals of Brahmin gods. Hindu logic was incomprehensible to the Greeks. They wanted to destroy it. They employed the Brahmin stooges to do their dirty work.

Sanskrit had only the Grandhika of Patna and the Avestan of the Brahmins. It was a Greek invention to deliberately destroy the Hindu logic and civilization.

The map below, derived from the 2011 Census data, shows only the naturally evolved dialects. The white space represents synthetic languages with artificial rules of syntax and grammar. Sanskrit is a language, not a natural dialect.



The Grandhika people (J2b) were forced to move east only after the global drought. Grandhika had dozens of natural dialects. Marathi (Grandhika + Kannada), Telugu (Grandhika + Teli), Odia (Grandhika + Mundari), and Sanskrit (Grandhika + Avestan) were synthetic languages with artificial rules of syntax and grammar.

All Sanskrit literature was the forbidden Avestan Brahmin literature transcribed into Sanskrit. Sanskrit (Grandhika + Avestan) was invented by the Greek colonialists to deliberately destroy the Hindu cultures. It was a synthetic language with artificial rules of syntax and grammar; it was never a natural dialect. The European historians who were unaware of the Hindus who lived only in Peninsular India for 60,000 years misinterpreted the recent Sanskrit rubbish as the Hindu religion.

Sanskrit was a mixture of only Grandhika and Avestan. Grandhika and Avestan were natural dialects. Sanskrit was a language, not a natural dialect. Using scientific tools, we separated Sanskrit literature into Avestan and Grandhika. The Avestan portion was a collection of non-verifiable and nonsensical statements, the exact opposite of Hindu logic. It was reduced to ashes when tossed in the fire of Hindu logic of hypothesis testing.

The excavated Grandhika portions of the Rig Veda, Bhagavad Gita, and Ramayana were pure Hindu logic. They had no Brahmin, Deva, Asura, Shiva, Vishnu, or Indra.

The archeological evidence has a fascinating story of the now lost Hindu history to tell. Hindu history in Peninsular India of 60,000 years was totally wiped out in a few decades by the synthetic Sanskrit language invented by the Greeks to promote their temple business. Temple, Sanskrit, and Brahmin were Greek inventions.
