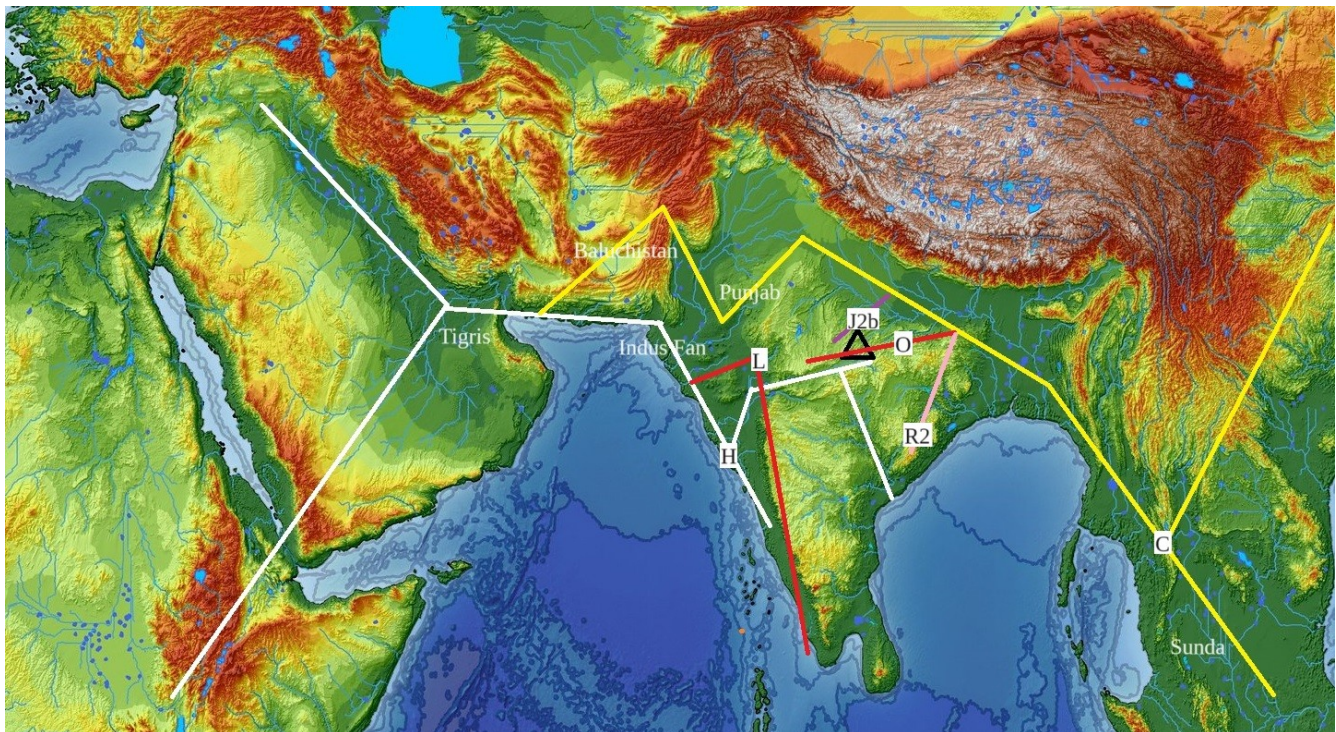


The Ancient History of India, an Archeological View *by Potluri Rao In Seattle ©2018 (CC BY 4.0)*

Indian history as portrayed in the Puranas is pure fiction, invented by Greeks, to deliberately destroy the ancient Hindu civilization. Hindu were the ancient advanced logic-based peace-loving people who lived in India for sixty thousand years. They never had a war or god. Greeks were the recent primitive ignorance-based warmongering people who evolved into a mature culture only six thousand years ago. They invented war and god to rob each other. They introduced war and god to India to deliberately and totally destroy the ancient Hindu civilization.

Idoltry was a Greek invention to rob people. They invested in temples of fictional gods with supernatural powers as a business to attract and rob people. Puranas were fictional stories of warmongering gods in temples, financed by the Greeks in India.

Humans evolved in Africa 200 thousand years ago.



The above map is a computer simulation of landscape of sixty thousand years ago when much of the world was covered with glaciers, and the seawater was much lower than the current levels.

People who share the same DNA are called a Haplogroup. Sixty thousand years ago, the F Haplogroup voluntarily left Africa to reach India. They were the Hindu. They were highly advanced logic-based culture that discovered dependable perennial rainwater resources in India. They followed the rainwater, not animals for food. They had abundant supply of food resources. They never had a war or god in sixty thousand years.

Sixty thousand years ago, the Hindu (F) were in the Tigris and Indus Fan. Forty thousand years ago, they split into different groups and spread out. Twenty thousand years ago, the glaciers started to melt, and the rising sea levels swallowed the Tigris and Indus Fan. The Hindu were forced to relocate to the Mt. Trikuta of the Vindhya, the only source of perennial rainwater on the subcontinent. They lived only in the peninsular India, to the south of Delhi, around the Trikuta.

The Hindu lived in peace and tranquility for sixty thousand years before the Greeks moved to India. They never had a war or god.

During the Ice Age, Europe was covered with glaciers. The ice melted ten thousand years ago. Some primitive hunters and gatherers moved to Europe in search of food. The DNA R1a, R1a1, and R1b evolved along the blue line, at the top of the map. The R1a were the Eastern Europeans. The R1a1 were the Central Europeans (Persian).



The R1b were the Western Europeans, the Greeks and Romans. The European cultures evolved only six thousand years ago. They moved south in search of food.

The Europeans grew up with animals, in a harsh climate with scarce food, and had to compete with the other animals for survival. They acquired animal survival instincts. They formed into rival packs and were constantly at war to rob each other. Getting rich by robbing other people was their political philosophy. They invented the concepts of King, War, Weapons, and God to rob each other. They were the exact opposite of the Hindu (F) who lived in peace and prosperity with abundant supply of food for the last sixty thousand years.

Four thousand years ago, there was a global drought that lasted for almost two hundred years. Europeans (R1) were forced to move south in search of food.

Some of the Eastern Europeans (R1a) moved south to reach Kashmir and a small area between the rivers Yamuna and Ganges, to the north of Delhi, called Gandhara.

The R1a existed only in Kashmir and Gandhara, only after the global drought. They were unaware of the Hindu (F) at the Trikuta. Gandhara and Trikuta were separated by a 500 mile wide wasteland with no reliable water supply to support human habitation.

The Central Europeans (R1a1) moved to Persia. They did not move to Kashmir or Gandhara. A subgroup of the R1a1 were called Brahmin. Brahmin were delusional. They believed that they had acquired supernatural powers with meditation (tapas). They were considered unworthy of living in a civilized society, and were expelled to Kashmir. Brahmin (R1a1) were refugees in Kashmir. They were insignificant in number.

Around 200 BCE, after Alexander, Greeks (R1b) occupied Persia (R1a1) and Kashmir (R1a).

Idolatry was a Greek invention. The Greeks transformed idolatry into a highly profitable Temple business. They invested in expensive temples to attract people to be robbed. They promoted local popular heroes to god status to be housed in temples. They discovered the delusional Kashmir Brahmin (R1a1) refugees to invent fictional stories of temple gods with supernatural powers.

Temple gods were invented by the Greeks, not Brahmin. Brahmin invented the fictional stories of temple gods. They were the fiction writers for hire on the Greek payroll.

The Greeks occupied Kashmir around 200 BCE. Between 200 BCE and 200 CE, they robbed only Kashmir. They invented the fictional Kashmir temple gods Shiva and Vishnu. The fictional stories of Shiva and Vishnu, invented by the Kashmir Brahmin (R1a1), were called Agamas. Agamas were invented only after 200 BCE.

Around 200 CE, the Greeks moved from Kashmir to Gandhara. Gandhara were the Eastern Europeans (R1a) who were constantly at war to rob each other. They adored war heroes. Rama and Krishna were the popular war heroes of the R1a. The Greeks (R1b) paid the delusional Kashmir Brahmin (R1a1), to invent fictional stories of Rama and Krishna (R1a) with supernatural powers. The fictional stories were called Puranas. Puranas were invented only after 200 CE.

Agamas were the fictional stories of Shiva and Vishnu invented to rob Kashmir. Puranas were fictional stories of Rama and Krishna invented to rob Gandhara. The Greeks actively promoted Agamas and Puranas as true stories of antiquity.

The gods Shiva, Vishnu, Rama, and Krishna were the European (R1) gods, nothing to do with the Hindu (F) who lived only to the south of Delhi. The Agamas and Puranas were fictional stories of the European culture of worship of war and god. They were actively promoted as the Hindu culture to deliberately destroy the Hindu civilization.

Around 500 CE, the Greeks discovered that there was a huge population at the Trikuta. They moved to the Trikuta with their highly profitable Temple business.

The people at the Trikuta (F) were unaware of Gandhara (R1a), Greeks (R1b), Brahmin (R1a1), Shiva (R1a1), Vishnu (R1a1), Rama (R1a), and Krishna (R1a). They never had a war or god in sixty thousand years. They could not relate to the warmongering Gandhara gods of the European culture. The initial attempt by the Greeks to market the temple gods Shiva, Vishnu, Rama, and Krishna was a total failure.

The Greeks (R1b) tasked the delusional Kashmir Brahmin (R1a1) to rewrite their Agamas and Puranas to incorporate the local legends and landmarks at the Trikuta. Rama and Krishna were given a total makeover. They were presented, not as the Gandhara warmongers, but as heroes who fought evil spirits to protect the family values.

The delusional Kashmir Brahmin (R1a1) produced the Uttara Ramayana (500 CE) for Rama, and the Bhagavata Purana (500 CE) for Krishna. The new and revised versions of the Puranas glorified the family values of the Hindu (F) at the Trikuta. Rama and Krishna were marketed as the protectors of Hindu values. The customized fictional Puranas sold like hotcakes. They were worship of war and god packaged and promoted as sacred texts. The gullible Hindu (F) swallowed it. Fiction was addictive. Hindu lost their soul and were transformed into the European culture of war and god worshipers. The ancient Hindu cultures were replaced by the European culture.

The Greeks moved to the Trikuta only around 500 CE. They deliberately and totally destroyed the ancient Hindu civilization, that existed in peace for sixty thousand years. They financed the Agamas and Puranas. Brahmin were their stooges.

Brahmin Muni (R1a1) claimed to have acquired supernatural powers through meditation (tapas). They were delusional. Anyone who believes that one can obtain supernatural powers through meditation belongs in a psychiatric ward.

In the Greek financed fictional Brahmin Ramayana (Uttara), Sakuntala's father appeared hundreds of years later as Rama's teacher. Rama's father ruled Ayodhya for thousands of years before reluctantly giving up reign. Rama ruled for eleven thousand years. People in the fictional Brahmin Ramayana routinely lived for thousands of years. It was Brahmin rubbish.

Life expectancy of thousands of years in the Puranas is sufficient to prove that they were fiction. Anyone, with critical thinking skills, would realize that no human ever lived much over 100 years. It was Brahmin rubbish.

The Kashmir Brahmin wanted a mean character Ravana as the antagonist. A Brahmin Muni used his supernatural powers to intentionally produce a baby with ten heads. Ravana, in the fictional Brahmin Ramayana, was a Brahmin child with ten heads. Only a delusional Brahmin Muni would abuse his supernatural powers to produce a grotesque ten-headed monster as his baby. It was Brahmin rubbish.

The God Gopala-Krishna was invented in the Greek financed fictional Bhagavata Purana (500 CE). His childhood pranks made him adorable. The God Radha-Krishna was invented in the fictional Brahma Vivarta Purana (700 CE). His amorous encounters with Radha and the milk-maids made him very popular.

Stories of Krishna as a miracle maker were in high demand. Puranas invented numerous stories of Krishna the miracle maker. A compilation of all the fictional stories of Krishna, from Puranas, was called the Harivamsa Purana. It was marketed as a part of the Greek financed fictional epic Mahabharata. It was Brahmin rubbish.

Vasudeva Krishna was a professor of logic of a University at the Trikuta. He wrote a book on logic called the Bhagavad Gita. It was a basic textbook on logic at all schools at the Trikuta, for over a thousand years, before the Greeks moved to the Trikuta.

The Greeks deliberately vandalized the epic Mahabharata to cast professor Vasudeva Krishna (J2b) as the warmongering Krishna (R1a) of Gandhara. They trashed the Gita and incorporated it as a part of the epic. They assassinated professor Vasudeva Krishna's character and his logic. The Gita logic was an existential threat to the Greek deception. The Greeks had to destroy professor Vasudeva Krishna and his logic. The extant Bhagavad Gita is Brahmin rubbish.

The original Rig Veda was a textbook on logic at the University. It was also trashed. The extant Rig Veda is Brahmin rubbish.

The Greeks (R1b) had a plan to destroy the Hindu (F) who did not believe in war and god. They paid the delusional Persian refugees in Kashmir (R1a1) to invent Puranas the fictional stories of warmongering gods and demons with supernatural powers.
