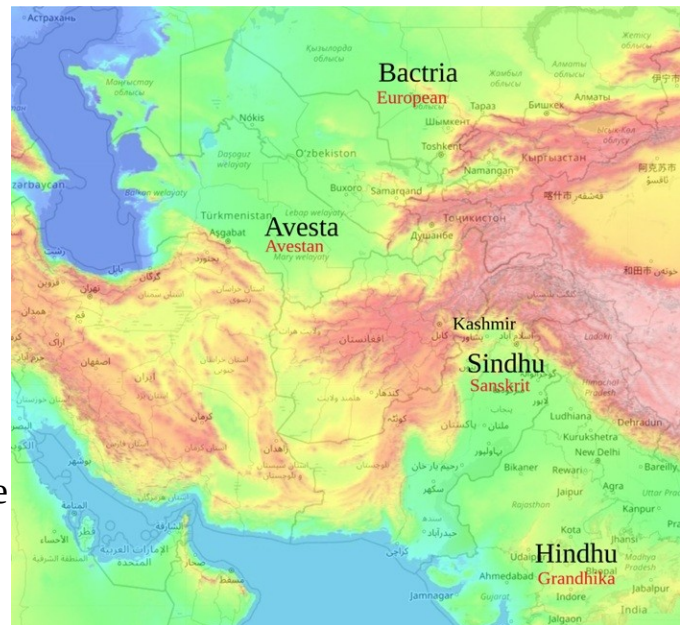


The Avestan Dialects: An Archeological View

The Sanskrit language was a Greek invention; it did not exist before the Greeks moved to Kashmir. Linguists made the false assumption that an Avestan dialect of South Bactria (Avesta) was Sanskrit. Avestan was a naturally evolved family of dialects of Persia; Sanskrit was a language of artificial rules of syntax and grammar. Dialects and languages are distinctly different classes of communication. Only dialects, not languages, are DNA samples.

North Bactria was occupied by the Eastern Europeans (DNA R1a) 4,000 years ago; they spoke a European language. South Bactria (Avesta) was occupied by Persians (DNA R1a1) 3,000 years ago; they spoke the Avestan dialects. Peninsular India, to the south of the Tropic of Cancer, was occupied by Hindus (DNA F) for over 60,000 years; they spoke the Grandhika dialects. Sanskrit is a mixture of only the Grandhika and Avestan dialects, invented by the Greeks. Languages were man-made to facilitate communication between different dialect groups of a location.



Persians (R1a1) offered prayers to nature, called Yasna, as an expression of gratitude. They had no gods in human form. Brahmins (Z93, R1a1-a1h), a subgroup of Persians, were con artists. They invented fictional gods in human form, called Vishnu, Shiva, and Indra, as miracle makers. They marketed their gods with fictional Yajna rituals as snake oil, a cure for any ailment. The Avestans kicked Brahmins out of Avesta into Kashmir for their unethical and immoral social behavior of robbing people with fictional stories.

Europeans (R1a) lived mostly in Bactria and Sindhu. They were called Sindhus; they had nothing to do with Hindus (F). Brahmins (Z93), the untouchable refugees, lived only in Kashmir. Greeks invented a new concept, called “Temple God,” to rob people. The gods of the Brahmins were snake oil, not “temple gods.” The Greeks in Kashmir discovered the unethical Brahmins and employed them to invent fictional stories of the fictional Greek temple gods to rob both the Sindhus and Hindus. They invented a

synthetic “Sanskrit” to conceal the scandalous Avestan past of Brahmins. The forbidden Brahmin Avestan literature of snake oil was resurrected in Sanskrit.

The language of the extant fictional stories Ramayana, Mahabharata, Buddhacarita, and the Vedas was Sanskrit (Avestan + Grandhika) with artificial rules of syntax and grammar invented by a Greek committee. It was a language, not a naturally evolved dialect of any people with identifiable DNA.

Using scientific tools, we separated the Sanskrit literature into Avestan and Grandhika sections. The Grandhika sections were pure Hindu Logic of Hypothesis Testing; the Avestan sections were plain rubbish of non-verifiable and nonsensical statements of unnatural characters and events, the forbidden Avestan Brahmin snake oil.

The excavated Grandhika sections had a different story of Hindus to tell. From an archeological perspective, all Sanskrit literature is plain rubbish. Brahmins were the Greek stooges who vandalized all logic-based Hindu literature into ignorance-based Sanskrit literature.
