

Hindu Cave Art: An Archeological View

DNA C and F were the original Homo Sapiens that voluntarily left Somalia in search of perennial rainwater resources 100,000 years ago. DNA O was a subgroup of the F; C and O lived in Sunda (Indonesia); F lived only in Peninsular India. C and O painted caves in Indonesia (Sulawesi) 60,000 years ago; F painted caves in India (Amaravati) 40,000 years ago. Pig paintings found at both locations look like mirror images. C and F must have invented the paint style before they were split 60,000 years ago.
