

## Rakhigarhi: An Archeological View

The excavation sites Harappa, Kalibangan, and Rakhigarhi were not along the current Indus River. People who were ignorant of geology made the false assumption that the sites were along the Indus. The current Indus is a recent avulsion of Himalayan snowmelt water. Asian Homo Sapiens (DNA C and F) voluntarily left Somalia 100,000 years ago and followed the Indian monsoon winds from the Arabian Sea to the Bay of Bengal. They were lowlanders. They lived only along the lowlands of perennial rainwater rivers of mountain ridges that were perpendicular to the monsoon winds. A detailed elevation map of Asia revealed the migration path of Asians. It was a different climate and landscape at the time of Asian migration.

In the following maps the area in green and yellow colors is the lowlands favored by the Asians. Asians lived only along the Baloch and Aravalli ridges. They avoided the flatland between the two ridges that was flood-prone.
