

Greeks in Rajasthan: An Archeological View



Before the Greeks moved to Nalanda, after the fall of the Gupta Empire around 500 CE, they lived in the northwest part of India that included the current Rajasthan State and Pakistan. They were known as the Yavanas. The Greeks that lived in Kashmir were known as Kushans.


Brahmins were invented by the Kushan Greeks (Kanishka) in Kashmir out of the untouchable Avestan refugees DNA Z93, who were kicked out of Avesta to Kashmir by Xerxes around 500 BCE.

The Z93 Brahmins in India were imported by the Greeks from Kashmir at great expense to deliberately destroy the Hindu civilization. The Z93 Brahmins in India are found in only three places: (1) Kashmir, (2) Rajasthan, and (3) Nalanda. They leave no trace of natural migration. The below maps are DNA Z93 samples found in Rajasthan.


DNA Z93 Brahmin Trivedi density interactive map
