The Bhagavad Gita Logic of Satyam the Truth

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Four thousand years ago, there was a Hindu University at the current Patna City (Bihar). The original Upanishads were textbooks on logic at the University. They explained the concept of Satyam the Truth, core of the Hindu logic. They were composed in the Grandhika language of the Agni, DNA J2b, who lived there for 20,000 years.

The extant versions of Upanishads composed in Sanskrit are not the originals. Avestan was a dialect of Persia. Zend Avesta, the sacred text of Persia, was composed in Avestan. Sanskrit was a mixture of only Grandhika of Patna and Avestan of Persia, separated by 2,000 miles. It was a synthetic language invented by the Greeks in Kashmir to deliberately vandalize Grandhika logic books to worship manuals of gods of the Zend Avesta of Persia.

Using scientific tools, we were able to identify and discard Avestan from Sanskrit to excavate the original Grandhika Upanishads.

What follows is the essence of the excavated original Grandhika Upanishads.

There were four books that specialized in the logic of Satyam the Truth: (1) Mundaka, (2) Mandukya, (3) Katha, and (4) Bhagavad Gita. The original Grandhika Gita presented the essence of the other three in a concise logical format.

What is the Truth (Satyam)?

The Mundaka defined Satyam as: Satyameva Jayate (Satyam is that, that is eternal).

The Gita elaborated the concept of Satyam as a relationship between Mind and Matter that is primeval, immutable, and eternal (Gita: 2.20). Mind cannot function in the land of Matter without Satyam. Satyam is the essential survival instinct acquired through the process of evolution by all life forms (Gita: 5.18).

Think of Mind and Matter as different kinds of atoms, similar to Male (plug) and Female (socket) of an electrical device. When an atom of Mind (plug) and an atom of Matter (socket) have the exact matching specifications then they fuse to form a Truth (Satyam) molecule. Mind and Matter are atoms: Satyam is a molecule.

Mind has no Matter. Matter has no Mind. Satyam is neither Mind nor Matter; it is both.

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The Bhagavad Gita on Satyam

There are infinite number of Satyam molecules, of compatible Mind and Matter atoms, that are preexisting and perpetual in the Universe.

The Gita called the infinite set of theoretically possible Satyam molecules of Mind and Matter atoms the Brahmanda (complete set). Brahmanda is beyond the comprehension of humans.

The Gita called the Satyam molecules discovered so far as Brahman, and the ones not yet discovered as Sruti. Both the Brahman (known) and Sruti (unknown) are Satyam. Satyam is preexisting, perpetual, and infinite in number. It is the Order in the Universe.

The Mundaka and Katha Upanishads stated, in identical words, that Satyam cannot be obtained from reading scriptures, intellect, rituals, penance, or good deeds. Satyam is beyond senses, mind, intellect, and awareness.

The Gita expressed the same view as: Vedas and rituals are as useless as a well in the middle of a flood (Gita: 2.46). People who market sacred texts and rituals are con-artists to rob gullible people. Truth is enclosed by ignorance thereby are mortals fooled (Gita: 5.15).

Only Brahman is the true knowledge (Satyam). It is discovered only by logicians who mastered the logic of Satyam.

Once discovered, Satyam molecules replicate and spread amongst life forms just like a virus. Satyam is propagated when people converse. Evolution encourages people to converse to spread Satyam. Satyam is the survival instinct required for self-preservation in all life forms. It is the substance of Evolution.

Our awareness of our surroundings (Reality) is the collection of Satyam viruses we currently possess.

The same logic of Satyam is employed by all life forms. It is embedded in the genetic code. It is the survival instinct.

As explained in the Gita Upanishad: a Satyam molecule (Virus) cannot kill and cannot be killed (Gita: 02.19), it has no birth or death (Gita: 02.20), and it is beyond senses, mind, and intellect (Gita: 3.42).

The Brahma Sutra, a textbook on logic at the University, presented a system of logic to verify whether a Proposition (Hypothesis) is a Satyam molecule. It was a synthesis of all the textbooks on logic at the University. It was the Hindu Scientific Method.

Unfortunately, the original Grandhika Brahma Sutra and Upanishads are now lost. They were deliberately vandalized to Sanskrit worship manuals of fictional gods of the Persia Zend Avesta. The vandalism was financed by the Greek colonialists. All the books in Sanskrit were vandalized versions of Grandhika literature. Gods of the Zend Avesta of Persia were falsely promoted as Hindu gods. Hindu never had a war or god in 60,000 years.
